On arrival, follow the signs to the entry of our Jayco Mackay VIP campground. There is plenty of room, so you don't need to worry about missing out on a space. The van sites are marked out. You are welcome to park in the location of your choosing. Park within an allocated site, reversing your caravan in. If you are travelling with friends you are welcome to reserve the surrounding site for them.

- Your \$10 food voucher to use on Saturday night

Check in times are as follows:

- Thursday 4PM, Friday 4PM, Saturday 8AM
- There you will receive your Welcome pack, included your wristbands, Saturday night Food Vouchers and information for the weekend.

Please be aware this is a licenced area, so no BYO alcohol. Food vendors will be available on the Friday night also. You will need your armband to gain entry so please ensure you "Check-In" first. Don't forget to take a camp chair.

Given the festival has so much to offer, you are free to plan your weekend as you please. We have organised a complimentary Sunday morning breakfast for our Jayco Customers where we are providing Bacon and Egg Burgers, juice, and hot drinks. We will have some special guests joining us for breakfast including Costa Georgiadis from Gardening Australia. Breakfast will be served from 8:00am-9:30am at the Jayco Mackay Tent.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Welcome, Jayco family, to the 2024 event. Please take a moment to carefully read the following information and ensure that you follow the instructions to guarantee safety and comfort for everyone on-site.

St Lawrence Wetlands Weekend 2024 officially commences on Friday 21 June 5pm and ends Sunday 23 June at 1pm. However, Camping is open since Wednesday the 20th. Check-in times are from 9am on Wednesday, 19 June or Thursday, 20 June 2024. Entry tickets must be purchased separately. Please bring your entry and caravanning tickets.

CAMPING AREA AND ACCESS:

Jayco's Campsite area is at the sportsgrounds. 1 Railway Parade, St Lawrence, QLD, 4707. Access to the sportsgrounds is via Railway Parade and turning left before the Bowls Club or Evans Street (See map below). If you are unsure of the exact location of the sports grounds, please phone Dayana Jimenez on **(M) 0473 053 827** or alternatively Jodie Hart on **(M) 0400 001 253** upon arrival for assistance.

PEDESTRIANS AND VEHICLE MOVEMENT:

Please be aware that the stallholders' bump-in and out access is near the Jayco's Campsite area. From 11am on Friday until 8am on Saturday, and Sunday after 11am, there may be significant vehicle movement. Safety is a priority, so please use pedestrian access and use caution from vehicle access.

CAMPFIRES

Campfires are permitted. Each fire must be suitably contained enclosed in a fireplace, constructed to prevent the escape of fire or embers and each fire must be less than one metre in all directions. Each fire is to be positioned in a cleared area with no overhanging branches (at least three metres away from tents and other camping equipment must be stored well away, especially flammable items). All fires must be attended to at all times when the fire is alight. Bring your own firewood supply as collection of firewood on the surrounding properties is prohibited. A limited supply of firewood is sold at the St Lawrence general store.

QUIET TIME

Quiet time in the campground kicks in at 10:30pm. Please be mindful and respect our neighbours.

BLACKWATER/ TOILET CASSETTES/ GREYWATER

You must take ALL your blackwater (including toilet cassettes) back to the dump points. These are located at the St. Lawrence Recreation Grounds, and at 1 Esplanade, Carmila QLD 4739, (72km North). You must catch all greywater (e.g. dish water) and take it back to dump points. We can also accept a limited amount of excess greywater on site at each permanent toilet block.

TOILETS AND SHOWERS:

There are no showers at the Jayco campsite area. Cold shower amenities are available at the sportsground main event area, and hot showers at the recreational grounds (593 St Lawrence Connection Road, St Lawrence). If you plan to use your own camp shower, please see the greywater policy above.

There are blocks of toilets, Showers and accessible toilets are also available at the St. Lawrence Centenary Hall, 7 Railway Parade, St. Lawrence, and the sports grounds. If you require any accessibility facilities or related services, please make yourself known at the information booth, or contact the St. Lawrence Isaac Regional Council Office at 1300 ISAACS (1300 472 227).

ALCOHOL

Alcohol consumption is permitted in your campsite area, but it is not to enter the main event area in accordance with Section 173 C of the *Liquor Act 1992*.

GENERATORS

Generators are permitted but can only run between 8am and 8pm.

DOGS

St. Lawrence Wetlands Weekend is a pet-friendly event but are not allowed at any of the signature ticketed food experience events or on any of the wetland tours (service dogs permitted).

Pets must be leashed at all times. Please pick-up after your dog and dispose of waste in the available bins. As a dog owner, you are personally liable for any property or personal damage caused by your dog. Please attend to barking dogs promptly to minimise disruption to fellow attendees.

RECYCLING

Recycling bins for aluminium cans and PET plastic will be located throughout the sportsground event area and near the toilet blocks. Please deposit your cans and PET bottles in the yellow lid bin available to contribute to a sustainable event.

RUBBISH

Please ensure that you collect all your campsite rubbish and dispose of it either in the bins near the toilet blocks in the sportsground event area or at the designated dump points. Let's keep our campsites perfectly clean!
